### 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 57

February 1, 2001 - Introduced by Representatives Black, Urban, Gronemus, GROTHMAN, MORRIS\_TATUM, BOCK, POWERS, HUBER, BOYLE, YOUNG, CUNDERSON, J. LEHMAN, MEYERHOFER, CARPENTER, LASSA, POCAN, BALOW, BERCEAU and WILLIAMS, cosponsored by Senators BAUMGART and M. MEYER. Referred to Joint survey committee on Tax Exemptions.

AN ACT to create 77.54 (14v) of the statutes; relating to: a sales and use tax 1 2 exemption for nonprescription drugs.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales tax and use tax exemption for nonprescription drugs. This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on tax exemptions for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Section 1.** 77.54 (14v) of the statutes is created to read:

77.54 (14v) The gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use, or other consumption of honnarcotic drugs which may be sold without a prescription and

which are prepackaged for use by consumers, and labeled in accordance with the

requirements of state and federal law.


