Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the department of veterans affairs to provide funding to the Korean War Memorial Association of Wisconsin for the perpetual care of the Korean War memorial located at Plover. This bill creates a continuing appropriation and appropriates \$90,000 for such purpose.
