

## 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 80

February 1, 2001 - Introduced by Representatives SCHNEIDER, ZIEGELBAUER, GRONEMUS, KREUSER, BOYLE and WILLIAMS. Referred to Committee on Insurance.

1     **AN ACT to create** 610.75 of the statutes; **relating to:** disclosure by insurers and  
2     intermediaries of identifying information.

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### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill requires an insurance agent to disclose to any person who applies for insurance, both orally and in writing, any information identifying the person that the agent has provided to or received from a national or statewide database. The bill also requires an insurer to disclose to each insured under each policy issued by the insurer, in writing annually or at renewal if renewal is on an annual basis or more often, any information identifying the insured that the insurer has provided to or received from a national or statewide database.

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***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3     **SECTION 1.** 610.75 of the statutes is created to read:  
4     **610.75 Disclosure of identifying information. (1)** In this section:  
5     (a) "Computer system" has the meaning given in s. 943.70 (1) (e).  
6     (b) "Data" has the meaning given in s. 943.70 (1) (f).
