

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, every employer employing employer in any manufacturing, mechanical or mercantile establishment in this state must provide suitable seats for its employer and must permit its employer to use those seats when not necessarily engaged in the active duties for which they are employed. This bill specifically includes retail stores in the coverage of those requirements, specifies that the seat provided for an employer must be in reasonable proximity to the area in which the employer is employed and requires the employer to permit the employer to use the seat for intermittent rest not only when the employer not necessarily engaged in the active duties for which the employer is employed, but also when the employer is not required to stand in order to perform the duties for which the employed.
