SECTION #.

Section #. 36.11 (8) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

Except as provided in par. (b)(m), the board

36.11 (8) (b) ~~The board~~ shall establish fines for the violation of any rule made under par. (a). The institutions are authorized to collect such fines together with moneys collected from the sale of parking permits and other fees established under par. (a) and such moneys shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to s. 20.285 (1) (h), to be used only for the purpose of developing and operating parking or other transportation facilities at the institution at which collected and for enforcing parking rules under par. (a).

36.11(8)(bm) No fine may be charged for a parking violation, other than a violation of ~~state or local law~~ relating to parking for motor vehicles used by the physically disabled, occurring during the period beginning on the first day <sup>on</sup> which final examinations are administered in a semester and ending on the seventh day after the last final examination is administered in <sup>that</sup> that semester.

Section #. 38.14 (13) of the statutes is amended to read:

38.14 (13) PARKING REGULATIONS AND FEES. The district board may adopt resolutions regulating the parking of motor vehicles on property under its jurisdiction. The resolutions may establish a fee for the parking of motor vehicles by students, faculty, staff and visitors and fines for the violation of any parking regulation. Nothing in this subsection requires that all users of the parking facilities be charged a parking fee.

ANALYSIS

This bill prohibits the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin System and a technical college district board from charging a fine for a parking violation that occurs during the period beginning on the first day on which final examinations are administered and ending on the seventh day after the last final examination is administered in that semester. The bill does not apply to violations of state or local law relating to parking of motor vehicles used by the physically disabled.
