## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the use of cyanide and cyanide compounds in mining for metallic minerals and processing metallic ore.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 293.67 of the statutes is created to read:
- **293.67 Use of cyanide in mining.** No person may conduct mining or metallic
- 5 ore processing using cyanide or a cyanide compound.
