1 AN ACT to amend 20.445 (3) (md); and to create 20.255 (2) (kn) and 49.175 (1)  
2 (zo) of the statutes; relating to: grants for after-school care programs and  
3 making appropriations.

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

\* This bill authorizes the state superintendent of public instruction to award grants to school districts in the 2000-01 school year <sup>and 2001-02</sup> for after-school care programs. To be eligible to receive a grant, a school district must enroll pupils who are eligible to receive money under the federal temporary assistance to needy families (TANF) program and who would otherwise be unsupervised by an adult in the afternoon after school. The state superintendent must evenly distribute the grants among rural, suburban and urban school districts.

For further information see the **state and local** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

**The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:**
