Affected Chapter 20 Appropriations

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires school boards to provide their pupils' parents or guardians with copies of materials that will be used in connection with written or recorded surveys or questionnaires, and to obtain parental consent for each survey or questionnaire conducted. The bill provides a forfeiture for failure to obtain the required consent.

Costs to local districts as a result of this bill are related to the time that staff will devote to mailing copies of surveys, questionnaires and consent forms. While these costs are indeterminable, it is possible that local school districts might be able to absorb them in their annual budgets. Other costs associated with this bill are related to forfeitures by school board officers, employees or agents who do not obtain the required consent of parents or guardians before administering certain surveys or questionnaires to pupils. These costs are also estimated to be indeterminable.
