

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary: This bill allows a person in the business of processing wild game to destroy or give to a charitable organization game or wild animal carcasses if the customer fails to claim the game or carcass. If the processor has had the game or carcass for 5 days after written notification of removal has been delivered to the customer, the processor may dispose of it.

Fiscal Estimate: This bill will not create any fiscal effect for the Department of Natural Resources.

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
