



AN ACT ...; relating to: a sales tax and use tax exemption for devices designed

2 to assist the visually impaired.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales tax and a use tax exemption for devices that are designed to assist the visually impaired.

This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on tax exemptions for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 77.54 (46) of the statutes is created to read:

77.54 (46) The gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use or other consumption of devices that are designed to assist the visually impaired, including video magnifiers, scanners for reading printed material and computer modifications.

In this subsection, "visually impaired" has the meaning given in s. 15.51(4).

SECTION 2. Effective date.



Technical Memorandum on AB 122 - Sales and Use Tax Exemption for Devices

Designed to Assist the Visually Impaired

The Department of Revenue would like to alert the sponsor that this bill would provide an exemption for any device that is used to assist the visually impaired, whether or not the device is used in visual assistance. In other words, the exemption could apply to almost any device purchased by a visually impaired person. For example, a garage door opener used to assist a visually impaired person in opening his or her garage door would be exempt.

Thus, the sponsor may wish to limit the exemption to devices used exclusively by visually impaired persons for visual assistance.
