**1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 130**

February 16, 1999 - Introduced by Representatives J. LEHMAN, STEINBRINK, RYBA, POCAN, BLACK, PLOUFF, BOCK, MEYERHOFER, COLON, BOYLE and KREUSER, cosponsored by Senators PLACHE, MOEN and DECKER. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 118.01 (2) (c) 6. of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring  
2 instruction in public schools on the history of organized labor in America and  
3 the collective bargaining process.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires that every school board's instructional program in state, national, and world history include information on the history of organized labor in America and the collective bargaining process.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

SECTION 1. 118.01 (2) (c) 6. of the statutes is amended to read:

118.01 (2) (c) 6. Knowledge of state, national, and world history, including knowledge of the history of organized labor in America and the collective bargaining process.
