This bill requires all public and charter school pupils, when addressing the employes of the school they are attending, to use the term "ma'am," sin, "mr.,", "mrs. , miss for "ms.) as appropriate. The requirement first applies in the 2000 000 school year to pupils in grades kindergarten to d. One grade is added in each succeeding school year. The bill directs each school board (and the governing body of each charter school that is not an instrumentality of a school district) to establish disciplinary procedures and measures for pupils who violate the requirement. Discipline may include community service but may not include suspension or expulsion.
