**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill creates a specific violation for operating a vehicle with a tinted cover over the license plate, or with a bracket or clear cover that interferes with normal reading of the license plate number, symbol, or renewal tag. The bill also establishes that the first offense requires a mandatory \$20 forfeiture with no additional court costs or assessments; second and subsequent convictions within one year allow a discretionary forfeiture of up to \$200, plus added court costs and assessments.

In addition, the bill requires motor vehicle dealers to provide a registration plate bracket for the front of the vehicle as well as the rear, if the vehicle is required to have two plates. The bill establishes a penalty as a forfeiture of \$10 - \$200 for each violation.

This bill has no fiscal impact on the Department of Transportation or on the Transportation Fund.


