1 AN ACT to amend 20.505 (1) (ng) (title); and to create 16.40 (22) and 20.505 (1)
2 (nh) of the statutes; relating to: proceeds from the sale of forest products at
3 Badger Army Ammunition Plant and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current federal law authorizes the sale of forest products produced on land owned or leased by a federal military department. The state in which the military installation or facility from which the forest products are sold is located is entitled to a portion of the proceeds of the sale. The state's share must be used to benefit the public schools and public roads of the county in which the military installation or facility is situated.

This bill appropriates all moneys received by the state under this federal law from the sale of forest products at Badger Army Ammunition Plant in Sauk County to the department of administration (DOA). The bill directs DOA to distribute 50% of the amount received to the school districts located in Sauk County and the other 50% to Sauk County for the benefit of the public roads in that county.

For further information see the ***state and local*** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

BILL

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SECTION 1. 16.40 ⁽²³⁾ ~~(22)~~ of the statutes is created to read:

16.40 ⁽²³⁾ ~~(22)~~ SALE OF FOREST PRODUCTS AT BADGER ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT. (a)
Annually distribute an amount equal to 50% of the amount appropriated under s. 20.505 (1) (nh) to the school districts located in whole or in part in Sauk County in proportion to the number of pupils in each such school district's membership, as defined in s. 121.004 (5), in the previous school year who were residents of that county in the previous school year.

(b) Annually distribute an amount equal to 50% of the amount appropriated under s. 20.505 (1) (nh) to Sauk County for the benefit of the public roads in Sauk County.

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SECTION 2. 20.505 (1) (ng) (title) of the statutes ^X as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act ~~24~~ is amended to read:

20.505 (1) (ng) (title) *Sale of forest products at Fort McCoy; funds for public schools and public roads.*

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SECTION 3. 20.505 (1) (nh) of the statutes is created to read:

20.505 (1) (nh) *Sale of forest products at Badger Army Ammunition Plant; funds for public schools and public roads.* All moneys received from the sale of forest products at Badger Army Ammunition Plant under 10 USC 2665 for distribution to Sauk County and to the school districts located in Sauk County under s. 16.40 ~~(22)~~ ⁽²³⁾.
