INS A

Current law prohibits a school board from beginning the school term before ^{September} September 1, unless it holds a public hearing and adopts a resolution ~~between~~ after ^{June} June 30.

This bill allows a school board to begin the school term before September 1 if it holds a public hearing and adopts a resolution between January 1 and May 15

of an odd-numbered year. The resolution applies to the ~~beginning of the school term~~ beginning in ^{the fall of} that year and ^{the school term beginning in the fall of} the succeeding year.

The bill's provisions first apply to the school term beginning in the fall of 2023.
