

**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 165**

May 15, 2001 – Offered by Representative OLSEN.

1 **AN ACT** *to repeal and recreate* 118.045 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** the
2 commencement of the school term in public schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 118.045 (3) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

4 118.045 (3) A school board may commence the school term before September
5 1 in an odd-numbered year and in the succeeding even-numbered year if all of the
6 following apply:

7 (a) At the annual meeting held in a common or union high school district in the
8 previous even-numbered year, a public hearing is held on the issue.

9 (b) If the school district is not a common or union high school district, the school
10 board holds a public hearing on the issue after May 14 and before October 1 in the
11 previous even-numbered year.
