1 AN ACT *to repeal and recreate* 118.045 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** the commencement of the school term in public schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 118.045 (3) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:
 - 118.045 **(3)** A school board may commence the school term before September 1 in an odd–numbered year and in the succeeding even–numbered year if all of the following apply:
 - (a) At the annual meeting held in a common or union high school district in the previous even–numbered year, a public hearing is held on the issue.
 - (b) If the school district is not a common or union high school district, the school board holds a public hearing on the issue after May 14 and before October 1 in the previous even–numbered year.

(c) Following the public hearing under par. (a) or (b), but before the employment
relations commission receives a notice of the commencement of contract negotiations
under s. 111.70 (4) (cm) 1. for the collective bargaining agreement whose term begins
in the succeeding odd-numbered year, the school board adopts a resolution to that
effect.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

(1) This act first applies to the commencement of the school term in the 2003-04 school year.
