2001 AB<sup>↓</sup>169 sets the fee for commemorative birth certificates and marriage certificates at \$42, \$35 of which must be forwarded to the state treasurer, deposited in the appropriation account created by the bill, and used for child care scholarships, the administration of that scholarship program, and the administration of the sale of those certificates. As DHFS<sup>✓</sup> correctly points out, however, the bill leaves ambiguous the disposition of the \$7 difference between the \$42 fee and the \$35 that is forwarded to the state treasurer.

Accordingly, this amendment reduces the fee from \$42 to \$35<sup>✓</sup> as originally requested and requires the *entire amount* to be forwarded to the state treasurer, deposited in the appropriation account created by the bill, and used for child care scholarships, the administration of that scholarship program, and the administration of the sale of those certificates, *including advertising that those certificates are available for sale*. Under s. 49.135 (3)<sup>✓</sup>, as created by the bill, the secretary of workforce development will confer with the state registrar of vital statistics to determine the appropriate amount to be transferred to DHFS for administration of the sale of the certificates, including advertising their availability for sale.

Gordon,

Thank you for sending the draft amendment (LRB-a0384/1) over so quickly. However, the effect of the draft amendment is not exactly the direction we want to take.

Please draft an amendment to AB 169 that will make the following changes:

- **Page 3, Line 20**

Delete: "and the secretary shall transfer an amount determined by the secretary, after consultation with the state registrar of vital statistics, to the appropriation under s. 20.435(8)(kx) to pay for the costs of administering the sale of commemorative birth certificates and marriage certificates under s. 69.21 (2m)."

- **Page 5, Line 12**

After "(g)" insert, "and \$7 of which shall be forwarded to the appropriation under 20.435(8)(kx) to pay for the costs of administering the sale of commemorative birth certificates and marriage certificates under 69.21(2m)."

I'm not sure if this is the exact language that needs to be included in the draft amendment, but the intent of the amendment will be to specify that the commemorative birth and marriage certificates will be sold for \$42— \$35 of which will be used strictly to fund the childcare education scholarships and \$7 of which will be allocated to the state registrar (DHFS) to administer (design, print, market and sell) the commemorative certificate program.
