Each political party shall hold a state postprimary convention biennially on a date to be fixed by the committee but not later than September state central Candidates for elective offices may be nominated at conventions. Such nominations shall be certified to the Secretary of State by the chairperson and secretary of the The certificates shall have the same force and convention. effect as nominations in primary elections. The convention shall formulate and promulgate a state platform, select a state central committee, select electors for President and Vice President of the United States, and transact the business which is properly before it. One presidential elector shall be chosen from each congressional district, and two presidential electors shall be chosen at large. The officers of the convention shall certify the names of the electors to the Governor and Secretary of State.

The Governor shall provide each presidential elector with a list of all the electors. If any elector is absent or if there is a deficiency in the proper number of electors, those present shall elect from the citizens of the state so many persons as will supply the deficiency immediately issue a certificate of election, signed by those present or a majority of them, to the person or persons so In case of failure to elect by 3 p.m. of such day, chosen. AN ACT ...; relating to: the method of selecting presidential electors

Under current law, independent and write-in candidates for president and vice president and the political parties nominate one presidential elector from each congressional district and selectors from the state at large. At the election for president and vice president, a vote for a particular candidate is a vote for that candidate's presidential electors. Currently, the presidential electors are elected on a statewide basis. Following the election, all of the presidential electors representing the candidates who win the statewide vote are, with certain limited exceptions, bound to vote for those candidates when the presidential electors convene to vote for president and vice president.

Under this bill, one presidential elector is elected from each congressional delector district and two presidential electors are elected from the state at large. However. if a candidate wins a majority of the congressional districts, the candidate receives two additional presidential electors and no presidential electors are elected from the state at large. Under this bill, following the election, one presidential elector representing the candidates who win the vote in each congressional district and, if applicable, the two presidential electors representing the candidates who win the statewide vote are, with certain limited exceptions, bound to vote for those candidates when the presidential electors convene to vote for president and vice president. The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Section 1.** 7.70 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

7.70 (5) (b) For presidential electors, the elections board shall prepare a certificate showing the determination of the results of the canvass and the names of the persons elected or deemed elected under s. 8.25 (1), and the governor shall sign, affix the great seal of the state and transmit the certificate by registered mail to the U.S. administrator of general services. The governor shall also prepare 6 duplicate originals of such certificate and deliver them to one of the presidential electors on or before the first Monday after the 2nd Wednesday in December.

AN ACT to amend 8.25 (1) of the statutes; relating to: the method of selecting

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the political parties and the independent and write-in candidates for president and vice president nominate one presidential elector from each congressional district and two electors from the state at large. At the election for president and vice president, a vote for a particular candidate is a vote for that candidate's presidential electors. Currently, the presidential electors are elected on a statewide basis. Following the election, all of the presidential electors representing the candidates who win the statewide vote are, with certain limited exceptions, bound to vote for those candidates when the presidential electors convene to vote for president and vice president.

Under this bill, one presidential elector is elected from each congressional district and two presidential electors are elected from the state at large. However, if one state of candidates wins a majority of the congressional districts, that state of candidates receives two additional presidential electors irregardless of the statewide vote for president and vice presidents. Under this bill, following the election, one presidential elector representing the candidates who win the vote in each congressional district and, if applicable, the two presidential electors representing the candidates who win the statewide vote are, with certain limited exceptions, bound to vote for those candidates when the presidential electors convene to vote for president and vice president. If a state of candidates receives two additional presidential electors as a result of winning a majority of the congressional districts,

those electors also are, with certain limited exceptions, bound to vote for that slate of candidates.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 8.25 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

8.25 (1) Presidential electors. By general ballot at the general election for choosing the president and vice president of the United States there shall be elected as many electors of president and vice president as this state is entitled to elect senators and representatives in congress. One elector of president and vice president shall be elected from each congressional district and, unless any candidates for president and vice president receive a plurality of the votes cast in a majority of the congressional districts, 2 electors of president and vice president shall be elected from the state at large. If any candidates for president and vice president receive a plurality of the votes cast in a majority of the congressional districts, the 2 at-large electors for those candidates who were nominated under s. 8.18 or the 2 at-large presidential electors listed by those candidates under s. 8.185 (2) or 8.20 (2) (d) shall be elected in lieu of any electors elected from the state at large. A vote for the president and vice president nominations of any party is a vote for the electors of the nominees.


