We believe that this bill is consistent with the intent of the instructions that you sent, but the bill doesn't actually require any state governmental entity or business to take any specific action. Do you want to require local governmental units, state governmental entities, or businesses to take some specific action by a certain date or to report to any governmental agency on their progress? Do you want the bill to contain some sort of enforcement mechanism to ensure that the covered entities actually investigate the feasibility of using unique personal identifiers? If so, do you want some sort of penalty provision for noncompliance?
