Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law specifies a sum certain in each fiscal year for the amount appropriated for certain higher education grants awarded by the higher educational aids board and for certain minority undergraduate grants awarded by the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin System (board of regents).

Under this bill, the amount appropriated in each fiscal year for both types of grants depends on whether undergraduate tuition at institutions within the University of Wisconsin System in the current academic year has increased or decreased as compared to the previous academic year. By February 1 before the beginning of the next fiscal year, the higher educational aids board and the board of regents are required to determine the percentage of such an increase at each such institution. The appropriation for the next fiscal year is determined by increasing the amount of the appropriation in the current fiscal year by the highest percentage increase. If tuition has decreased or stayed the same at each such institution, the appropriation for the next fiscal year is the amount appropriated in the current fiscal year.
