If it is assumed that the bill <u>does not prohibit</u> state and local governments from requiring information as a condition of receiving government services, the bill has no fiscal effect on the Department or local health and social service agencies. If the bill <u>does prohibit</u> the Department and local agencies from requiring this information as a condition of receiving government services, the bill would have a significant fiscal impact on state and local government agencies because services could not be provided without parental/guardian consent to release information (contrary to current state, local and federal requirements) and agencies would be burdened by the administrative requirement to provide consenting parents and guardians information about the source of the information, provide a copy of the information, identify the persons to whom the information is to be disclosed, and the procedures by which a parent or guardian may correct, revise or withdraw the information. The fiscal effect cannot be determined.
