Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB 203 allows probation/parole agents whose primary duty is to locate absconders to carry firearms. The bill requires the Department of Corrections (DOC) to select the type of firearm that absconder agents may use and requires DOC to provide ammunition for the firearm to them. The absconder agent, however, would be responsible for purchasing the firearm and the holster. In addition, DOC must provide training regarding firearm safety, credentials and a badge to each absconder agent.

Currently, DOC probation and parole agents do not carry firearms. The estimated annual cost of allowing absconder agents to carry firearms is summarized below. Absconder agent turnover is estimated at 15% (4 absconder agents) for the purposes of the annualized estimate.
