7 4, Casimir Pulaski Day; March 17, for the Great Hunger in Ireland from 1845-50;

10 September 17, U.S. Constitution Day; September 28, Frances Willard Day; October  
11 9, Leif Erikson Day; October 12; ~~November 9, for the Holocaust of 1939-45;~~  
12 November 11; and Wednesday of the 3rd week in September, as part of Wonderful

1 Wisconsin Week under s. 14.16 (8), Wisconsin Day. If any such day falls on a  
2 Saturday or Sunday, the observance shall be on a school day immediately preceding  
3 or following. If school is held on June 14, that day shall be appropriately observed  
4 as Robert M. La Follette, Sr. Day. If the governor by proclamation sets apart one day  
5 to be designated as Arbor and Bird Day, under s. 14.16 (1), that day shall be  
6 appropriately observed; otherwise, the last Friday in April shall be observed as Arbor  
7 Day.

8 **SECTION 2. Effective date.**

9 (1) This act takes effect on July 1, 200<sup>2</sup>.
