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


1 AN ACT to create 106.01 (11) of the statutes; relating to: apprenticeship training
2 and making appropriations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of workforce development (DWD) may determine reasonable apprenticeship classifications, promulgate rules, issue general or special orders, hold hearings, make findings, and render orders as necessary to oversee the apprenticeship programs provided in this state.

This bill directs DWD to provide a trade masters pilot program to recognize advanced training and postapprenticeship achievements in three trades, crafts, or businesses, one of which must be in the industrial sector, one in the construction sector, and one in the service sector of the economy. In addition, the bill provides funding for the provision of that program and for promotional materials directed at encouraging youth to participate in apprenticeship programs. Finally, the bill requires DWD to submit to the legislature, by July 1, 2005, an evaluation of the effectiveness of the trade masters pilot program in producing workers with advanced skills beyond the apprentice level.

The biennial budget act establishes the appropriation schedule for the biennium. As such, that schedule may not be changed until the budget is enacted. Accordingly, this draft includes an effective date provision providing that the appropriation changes made in the draft take effect on the day after the budget takes effect.

Because the budget bill repeals and recreates the entire appropriation schedule, theoretically it could repeal s. 20.445 (1) (a), in which case the appropriation changes made by this draft would have no effect. Accordingly, you might wish to have this draft redrafted as a budget amendment or wait until after the budget is enacted to pursue enactment of this draft.
