7	other location properly marked with a "school crossing" sign of a type approved by
8	the department when children are <u>any of the following conditions exist:</u>
9	1. Any child is present.
10	SECTION 2. 346.57 (4) (b) 2. and 3. of the statutes are created to read:

346.57 (4) (b) 2. A school crossing guard is within a crosswalk at the
intersection or the other location or, if no crosswalk exists, is in the roadway at the
intersection or the other location.
3. A school crossing guard is placing in or removing from the roadway at or near
the intersection or the other location a temporary sign or device that guides, warns,
or regulates traffic.
SECTION 3. Initial applicability.
(1) This act first applies to vehicles operated on the effective date of this
subsection.
