The attached redraft of 1999 AB–505, authorizing a manufacturer's or rectifier's retail sale of intoxicating liquor manufactured or rectified on the premises from fermented fruit juice, limits authorized retail sales to sales for on–premises consumption. Is this your intent? Or do you intend the bill to also allow manufacturers to make retail (in addition to wholesale) sales for off–premises consumption under the described circumstances? (Rectifiers and manufacturers can presently make wholesale sales for off–premises consumption under the existing statute, but only rectifiers, and not manufacturers, can presently make retail sales for off–premises consumption under the existing statute.) In addition, do you wish to include any limitation on the hours during which these sales are permitted under s. 125.68 (4), stats.?

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
