Representative Ladwig:

This substitute amendment differs from the bill as follows:

1. 24 hours of training, not 16, are required.
2. Certificates must be renewed every 2 years upon payment of a \$20 fee.
3. Certificate holders must be under the direct supervision of licensed barbers or cosmetologists.
4. Certificate holders may not select products, perform analyses, or rinse out products used in curling, dyeing, tinting, coloring, bleaching, or waving hair. Regarding the prohibition on rinsing out products, I chose language that is consistent with the definition of barbering or cosmetology. That definition doesn't mention perming hair, but I think perming is covered under the various words used (e.g., curling or waving hair).
