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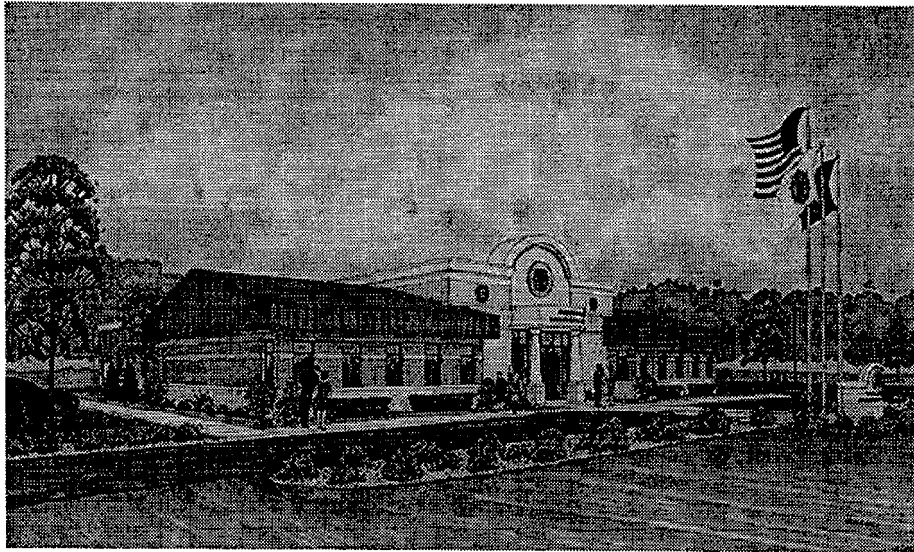

The American Legion Headquarters is located on American Legion Drive, which is a northerly extension of Village Road. A.L. Drive and Village Rd are accessed from Northridge Road which intersects with USH 51 from the west about 1/2 to 3/4 mile south of the IH 39/USH 51 Interchange.

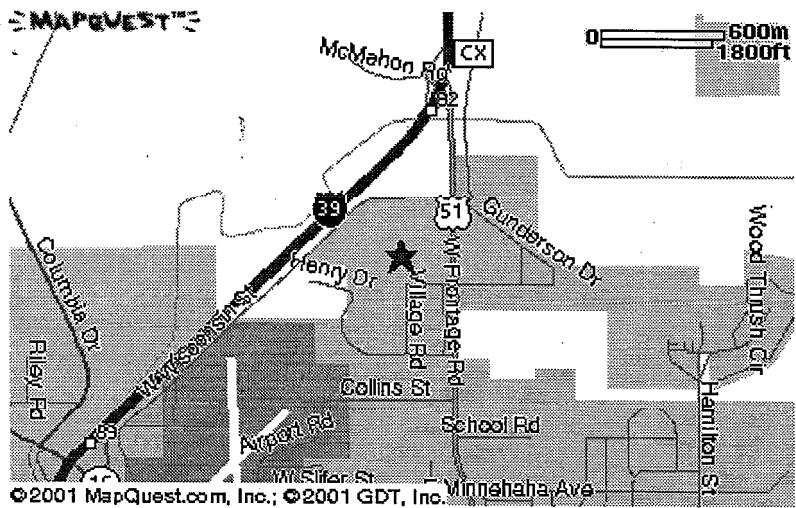

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) erects tourist-oriented directional signs to assist motorists traveling along highways. Tourist-oriented directional signs provide identification of and directional information for tourist-related businesses, services, or activities, which derive the majority of their income or visitors during the normal business season from motorists not residing in the immediate area where the business, service or activity is located.

This bill requires DOT, upon receiving an application and applicable fees, to erect two tourist-oriented directional signs along ~~USH 18 in Grant~~ County, for Wisconsin Badger Camp, Inc., a nonprofit corporation that provides educational and recreational opportunities in a summer camp setting for individuals with developmental disabilities.
