AN ACT ..., relating to: a sales and use tax exemption for textbooks.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 77.54 (46) of the statutes is created to read:

77.54 (46) The gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use or other consumption of textbooks that are required for a course offered by a university, college, technical college, or school approved under s. 45.54, located in this state and that are used by a student enrolled in the course.

SECTION 2. Effective date.


