	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
4	SECTION 1. 121.91 (4) (L) of the statutes is created to read:
5	121.91 (4) (L) The limit otherwise applicable to a school district's revenue
6	under sub. (2m) in any school year is increased by an amount equal to the amount
7	spent by the school district in that school year for safety measures designed to protect
8	pupils and staff and for security measures designed to prevent criminal activity in
9	schools, as determined by the state superintendent, but not more than an amount
10	equal to \$100 multiplied by the number of pupils enrolled. The state superintendent
11	shall promulgate rules specifying the safety and security measures that are eligible
12	for a revenue limit adjustment under this paragraph.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability. (1) This act first applies to the calculation of a school district's revenue limit for the 2002–03 school year.
