

**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 268**

October 16, 2001 – Offered by Representative BLACK.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 121.91 (4) (L) of the statutes; **relating to:** increasing a school
2 district’s revenue limit by the amount spent for school safety and security
3 measures and granting rule-making authority.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 121.91 (4) (L) of the statutes is created to read:

5 121.91 **(4)** (L) The limit otherwise applicable to a school district’s revenue
6 under sub. (2m) in any school year is increased by an amount equal to the amount
7 spent by the school district in that school year for safety measures designed to protect
8 pupils and staff and for security measures designed to prevent criminal activity in
9 schools, as determined by the state superintendent, but not more than an amount
10 equal to \$100 multiplied by the number of pupils enrolled. The state superintendent
11 shall promulgate rules specifying the safety and security measures that are eligible
12 for a revenue limit adjustment under this paragraph.
