1 AN ACT ~~...~~; relating to: reserved deer hunting back tag numbers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 29.561 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 29.561 (1) COLLECTION OF FEE. The department shall establish a system under
4 which the department shall reserve a deer hunting back tag number for a person who
5 ~~pays a reservation fee~~ applies for such a number. The department may limit the
6 number of back tag numbers that may be reserved under this system. Upon payment
7 of the an initial fee each year, the department shall issue ~~the same~~ a reserved back
8 tag number to that person. Except as provided in sub (1m), the department shall
9 issue, without charging a fee, the same back tag number to that person in each
10 subsequent year in which the department issues the person a deer hunting back tag.

11 Any person, including the department, who reserves a back tag number shall collect,

Cancellation of reserved number.

1 ~~in addition to each~~ and who collects a reservation fee, shall also collect an issuing fee
2 of 50 cents.

3 **SECTION 2.** 29.561 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 29.561 (1m) If the department issues a reserved back tag number under sub.
5 (1) and the person to whom it is issued does not use the reserved back tag number
6 for a specified number of deer hunting seasons, as determined by the department,
7 the department may cancel the reserved back tag number issued to that person. If
8 the department cancels the reserved back tag number, the department may issue a
9 different reserved back tag number to that person upon application and payment of
10 the initial fee as provided under sub. (1).

11 **SECTION 3. Effective date.**

12 (1) This act takes effect retroactively to March 1, 2000.
