Tim -

Kristina In our office (Rep. Ainsworth) has left on maternity leave. In her absence, I'm going to try and pick up where she left off. We recently received an e-mail from the State Patrol regarding an amendment to AB 289. You recently drafted an amendment LRBA0664/1 that substituted "26,000" for the weight limit for trucks affected by this bill. The State Patrol is in agreement with this figure but would like further clarification made as far as the term "gross vehicle weight" (Line 5 - Section 1). They would like a slight change for the wording to read "gross vehicle weight *rated*". The addition of the term "rated" would enable the truck in question to qualify for the amber light if it is *rated* at over 26,000 pounds without concern about loaded or empty weight.

Therefore, could you draft an additional amendment making this further clarification? Thank you, Tim. Please let me know if you have any questions.
