## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill may result in additional prosecutions, many of which would require jury trials. The actual number of prosecutions is not known and depends on the growth of the database against which DNA samples will be tested. Over time, as the database grows, more cold hits will occur and more cases will be brought to court.

The number of conviction that will be challenged in court as a result of new evidence developed by DNA testing is also unknown. The extent of the DA workload in these cases will be dependent on the DA office's assessment of the accuracy of the DNA analysis in each case. This judgementwill determine whether the DA supports or opposes the claim of innocence. Claims opposed will likely involve a greater amount of prosecutorial time.

## Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Unknown but should be monitored to determine if additional prosecutorial resources should be provided.
