Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, any vehicle of the department of transportation, or of a county or municipal highway department, that when used upon a highway creates a vehicular traffic hazard requiring the exercise of unusual care in approaching, overtaking, or passing may be equipped with a flashing red or amber dome-type lamp, or with two flashing red or amber lamps, one showing to the front and one showing to the rear.

This bill allows, but does not require, certain publicly owned or operated snowplows to be equipped with a green flashing, rotating, or oscillating lamp, instead of flashing red or amber lamps. ~~Under the bill, snowplows may be equipped with flashing red, amber or green lights.~~

Current law also prohibits any person from operating upon the left-hand side of a highway during hours of darkness any motor vehicle used in highway construction or maintenance, including snow and ice control, unless the vehicle or machinery is equipped with an auxiliary lamp projecting a flashing or revolving amber light. This bill allows snowplows that are equipped with green lights to be

operated upon the left-hand side of a highway when engaged in snow ^{and} ice control during hours of darkness.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. 347.23 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

2 347.23 (4) No person shall may operate upon the left-hand side of a highway
3 during hours of darkness any road machinery or motor vehicle used in highway
4 construction or maintenance, including snow and ice control, unless such vehicle or
5 machinery is equipped with an auxiliary lamp or lamps projecting a flashing amber
6 light visible from all directions for a 360-degree lens (beehive type lamp) or revolving
7 type lamp and visible front and rear for reflectorized stationary directional type
8 lamps. For flashing type lamps the number of flashes per minute shall be between
9 60 and 90. For revolving type lamps the revolutions per minute shall be between 45
10 and 90. The lenses of such auxiliary lamps shall not be less than 6 inches in diameter
11 for the reflectorized stationary directional type lamp; 3-3/4 inches minimum
12 diameter and 5-inch minimum height for the 360-degree lens (beehive type lamp);
13 and 3-3/4 inches minimum width and 4-5/8 inches minimum height for the revolving
14 type lamp. The lamps shall be equipped with bulbs of 50 candlepower minimum.
15 The lamps shall be mounted approximately midway between the transverse
16 extremities of the vehicle or machinery and at the highest practicable point. This
