Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This legislation eliminates the current system of public financing and replaces it with new system limited to gubernatorial and legislative campaigns. For purpose of this estimate the following grants would be given in the 2002 general election.

Governor

State Senate

This funding level would require a transfer of \$8,292,000 from GPR to the clean election fund established in the bill.

No assumptions are made for unencumbored seed money being transferred to the fund. No assumptions are made for GPR funds to match independent expenditures.

The Elections Board will incur one-time costs for revising, preparing, printing and distributing forms, information materials, manuals and training materials.
