1 AN ACT <sup>Generate</sup> ...; relating to: ~~the~~ <sup>Keep as is</sup> grants to World War II veterans and making  
2 an appropriation.

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

This bill requires the department of veterans affairs (DVA) to award a grant of \$500 to each World War II veteran who meets all of the following requirements:

1. The veteran served on active duty under honorable conditions in the U.S. armed forces during World War II. Current law defines World War II as the war period from August 27, 1940, to July 25, 1947.

2. The veteran is a resident of this state, has been a resident of this state for any consecutive <sup>five</sup> year period, or was a resident of this state at the time of his or her entry or reentry into service in the U.S. armed forces.

3. The veteran applies for the grant on an application developed by DVA.

Under the bill, an eligible veteran may only receive one grant.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

**The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:**

19 (c) *Eligibility requirements.* A World War II veteran is eligible for a grant under  
20 this subsection if the veteran meets all of the following requirements:

- 21 1. The veteran meets one of the following requirements:
  - 22 a. The veteran is a resident of this state.
  - 23 b. The veteran has been a resident of this state for any consecutive 5-year
  - 24 period following his or her entry or reentry into service.

Also, do you want to provide a date on which the program will end? The way the bill is drafted currently, DVA <sup>will be</sup> required to provide the \$500 grant to <sup>an</sup> ~~any~~ <sup>eligible</sup> veteran <sup>ever</sup> if the veteran applies for a grant in five years.

Representative Schneider:

I included residency requirements for the grant program that are similar to the residency requirements of most other veterans' benefit programs. Is this okay?

Your drafting instructions did not specify the amount that should be appropriated from the veterans trust fund for the grant program. Thus, the schedule entry contains zeros. When you know the amounts you wish to appropriate, please contact me and I will add the amounts to the schedule.

Also, s. 16.47 (2), stats., states that neither house may pass any bill containing an appropriation, increasing the cost of state government or decreasing state revenues by more than \$10,000 annually until both houses pass the executive budget bill, ~~except~~ <sup>unless</sup> ~~that~~ the governor or joint committee on finance or, under certain circumstances, the committee on organization of either house <sup>may</sup> ~~may~~ enact <sup>ed as an</sup> emergency appropriation bills <sup>✓</sup> prior to the passage of the executive budget bill.

Note that, if this bill is introduced and enacted as an emergency measure prior to passage of the budget, the appropriation set forth in this bill will be repealed by action of the budget bill (which repeals and recreates the appropriations schedule). You may instead wish to consider having this bill drafted as an amendment to the budget bill to include the correct appropriation line amount. Alternatively, you may wish to include an effective date that is later than the projected date for passage of the budget bill. Finally, you may instead wish to introduce this bill for potential passage after the passage of the budget bill. If you choose this option, please check with me after budget passage to ensure that the cross-references in this bill are still accurate and that the numbers for created statutes in the bill have not been supplanted by the budget bill.

Representative Schneider:

This draft appropriates GPR moneys instead of SEG moneys for the grant program. The draft does not, however, specifically earmark proceeds from the liquor tax for the program because I cannot draft such a provision without knowing the amount of the liquor tax proceeds you wish to use for the program. However, because the proceeds from the liquor tax are currently deposited in the general fund, and thus are GPR moneys, it is not necessary to specifically earmark the liquor proceeds for the grant program.
