1 AN ACT *to renumber* 36.11 (35) (title); *to renumber and amend* 36.11 (35); and
2 *to create* 36.32 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:** the use of a person's social
3 security number in his or her student identification number at private
4 institutions of higher education.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law ^{stat} ~~beginning January 1, 2000~~, the University of Wisconsin System, a technical college district board, a school board, and the governing body of a private school are prohibited from assigning to any student an identification number that is identical to or incorporates the student's social security number.

Beginning January 1, 2002, this bill extends this prohibition to private institutions of higher education located in this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 SECTION 1. 36.11 (35) (title) of the statutes, ~~as created by 1997 Wisconsin Act~~

6 ~~1228~~ is renumbered 36.32 (title).

7 SECTION 2. 36.11 (35) of the statutes, ~~as created by 1997 Wisconsin Act 1228~~, is

8 renumbered 36.32 (2) and amended to read:

ASSEMBLY BILL 28

SECTION 2

1 36.32 (2) ~~The board~~ An institution of higher education may assign to each
 2 student enrolled in the ~~system~~ institution a unique identification number. ~~The board~~
 3 An institution of higher education shall not assign to any student an identification
 4 number that is identical to or incorporates the student's social security number. This
 5 subsection does not prohibit ~~the board~~ an institution of higher education from
 6 requiring a student to disclose his or her social security number, nor from using a
 7 student's social security number if such use is required by a federal or state agency
 8 or private organization in order for the system or the student to participate in a
 9 particular program.

10 **SECTION 3.** 36.32 (1) of the statutes is created to read:

11 36.32 (1) In this section, "institution of higher education" means an institution
 12 within the system, or a private educational institution located in this state that
 13 awards a bachelor's or higher degree or provides a program that is acceptable toward
 14 such a degree.
