AN ACT to create 895.68 of the statutes; relating to: immunity in cases involving 1 2 wrongful birth and wrongful life. The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows: 3 **Section 1.** 895.68 of the statutes is created to read: 4 895.68 Liability exemption; wrongful birth and wrongful life. (1) In 5 this section: 6 (a) "Abortion" has the meaning given is s. 253.10 (2) (a). 7 (b) "Birth defect" has the meaning given in s. 253.12 (1) (a). 8 (c) "Developmental disability" has the meaning given in s. 51.01 (5) (a). 9 (d) "Physical disability" has the meaning given in s. 15.197 (4) (a) 2.

(e) "Wrongful birth action" means a cause of action that is brought by a parent,

legal custodian, or legal guardian and that seeks damages for the costs of raising a

- child who has any birth defect or any physical disability or developmental disability that existed at the time of the child's birth.
- (f) "Wrongful life action" means a cause of action that is brought by or on behalf of a child and that seeks the child's economic or noneconomic damages resulting from any birth defect or any physical disability or developmental disability that existed at the time of the child's birth.
- (2) In a wrongful birth action or a wrongful life action, a person is immune from civil liability for damages resulting from any birth defect or any physical disability or developmental disability that existed at the time of the child's birth if the person's act or omission contributed to a woman's decision not to undergo an abortion.

## **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

(1) This act first applies to acts or omissions occurring on the effective date of this subsection.
