- 4 **895.68 Liability exemption; wrongful birth and wrongful life. (1)** In this section:
 - (a) "Abortion" has the meaning given in s. 253.10 (2) (a).
 - (b) "Wrongful birth action" means a cause of action that is brought by a parent or other person who is legally required to provide for the support of a child and that seeks economic or noneconomic damages resulting from a condition of the child that existed at the time of the child's birth.

- (c) "Wrongful life action" means a cause of action that is brought by or on behalf of a child and that seeks the child's economic or noneconomic damages resulting from a condition of the child that existed at the time of the child's birth.
- (2) In a wrongful birth action or a wrongful life action, a person is immune from civil liability for damages resulting from any condition that existed at the time of the child's birth if the cause of action is based on a claim that the person's negligent act or omission contributed to the mother's decision not to undergo an abortion.
