RE: Drafting Instructions for a Substitute Amendment to 2001 Assembly Bill 365
DATE: February 25, 2002

This memorandum, prepared at your request, summarizes your drafting instructions for a substitute amendment to 2001 Assembly Bill 365. Assembly Bill 365 relates to the newspaper recycling fee and the recycled content of newsprint used in newspapers.

In particular, pursuant to your instructions, the substitute amendment should do all the following:

1. Authorize the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to reduce the target recycled content specified in s. 287.31 (3) (c) 3. or 4., Stats., by rule, to an amount equal to at least 33% if the DNR determines that it is not economically feasible for publishers of newspapers to meet the target recycled content specified in s. 287.31 (3) (c), Stats. The standard may be reduced only on a publisher-by-publisher basis, and not on a statewide basis. Any publisher who seeks to qualify for a reduction shall also implement an ISO 14000 equivalent environmental management system appropriate to the business and acceptable to the department, within a year of the rule change, and shall implement other old newsprint recycling or reuse activities, as agreed to by the department.
2. If the DNR reduces the target recycled content under item 1., authorize the DNR to increase the target recycled content in a subsequent year to an amount no more than 40% if the DNR determines that it is economically feasible for publishers of newspapers to meet the higher target recycled content.
