#### AMENDMENT TO ILLINIOS VEHICLE CODE.

The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding section 1-154.4 and changing sections 12-215 and 12-601 as follows:

(625 ILCS 5/1-154.4 new)

Nov. 21 00 12:09a

Sec. 1-154.4. Organ transport vehicle. A motor vehicle of the second division equipped and used exclusively for the transportation of organs for human transplant or the transportation of members of the surgical team performing the organ harvesting or transplant operations. Vehicles defined in this section shall be owned or operated by a company that has a contractual agreement with a federally designated organ procurement organization for the purposes stated in this Section.

(625 ILCS 5/12-215) (from Ch. 95 1/4, par.12-215) (text of Section after amendment by P.A. 89-507).

Sec. 12-215. Oscillating, rotating or flashing lights on motor vehicles. Except as otherwise provided in this code.

(c) The use of blue oscillating, rotating, or flashing lights, whether lighted or unlighted is prohibited except:

6. Vehicles that are equipped and used exclusively as organ transport. vehicles when used in combination with red oscillating, rotating, or flashing lights; furthermore, these lights shall only be lighted when the transportation is declared an emergency by a member of the transplant team or a representative of the organ procurement organization.

(625 ILCS 5/12-601) (from Ch. 95 1/4, par. 12-601) (text of Section after amendment by P.A. 89-687)

Sec. 12-601. Horns and warning devices.

(b) No vehicle shall be equipped with nor shall any person use upon a vehicle any siren, whistle, or bell, except as otherwise permitted in this section. Any authorized emergency vehicle or organ transport vehicle as defined in Chapter 1 of this Act may be equipped with a siren, whistle, or bell, capable of emitting sound audible under normal conditions from a distance of not less than 500 feet, but such siren, whistle or bell, shall not be used except when such vehicle is operated in response to an emergency call or in the immediate pursuant of an actual or suspected violator of the law in either of which events the driver of such vehicle shall sound such siren, whistle or bell, when necessary to warn pedestrians and other drivers of the approach thereof.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law generally prohibits any vehicle from being equipped with a flashing light. Exceptions to this prohibition include authorized emergency vehicles such as police vehicles, fire department vehicles, and ambulances. Current law also prohibits any vehicle other than an authorized emergency vehicle from being equipped with a siren. Under current law, an authorized emergency vehicle must be equipped with a siren and may be equipped with one or more flashing, oscillating, or rotating red lights. Only a police vehicle may be equipped with flashing, oscillating, or rotating red and blue lights.

Also under current law, when an authorized emergency vehicle is responding to an emergency call or in pursuit of an actual or suspected violator of the law, the operator is exempt from traffic restrictions relating to parking if the vehicle's warning lights are activated. The operator of an authorized emergency vehicle is also exempt from traffic restrictions relating to speed, traffic signals, and direction of travel if the vehicle's warning lights and siren are activated. Even when an authorized emergency vehicle is operated with the vehicle's warning lights and siren activated, the operator must drive with due regard under the circumstances for the safety of all persons.

This bill provides that motor vehicles used by an organ procurement organization or under an agreement with an organ procurement organization to transport organs for human transplantation or to transport medical personnel for

the immediate purpose of performing human organ harvesting or transplantation ("organ transport vehicles") are authorized emergency vehicles. Organ transport vehicles may be equipped with red or red and blue flashing, oscillating, or rotating lights and must be equipped with a siren. Organ transport vehicles are permitted the same traffic law exemptions, and subject to the same limitations, as other authorized emergency vehicles when they are transporting an organ for human transplantation or transporting medical personnel for the immediate purpose of performing human organ harvesting or transplantation.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 110.08 (1m) of the statutes is amended to read:

110.08 (1m) Each operator's license examiner shall receive informational training on the powers and duties of the department relating to organ donor information under s. 343.175 once every 2 years and, for operator's license examiners hired after January 1, 1997, prior to initial assignment to operator's license examining activities. The informational training under this subsection shall be developed by all organ procurement organizations, as defined in s. 343.01 (2) (dg) 340.01 (41k), in cooperation with the department.

SECTION 2. 340.01 (3) (dg) of the statutes is created to read:

340.01 (3) (dg) Privately owned motor vehicles being used by an organ procurement organization, or by any person under an agreement with an organ procurement organization, to transport organs for human transplantation or to transport medical personnel for the purpose of performing human organ harvesting or transplantation immediately after the transportation.

**SECTION 3.** 343.01 (2) (dg) of the statutes is renumbered 340.01 (41k).

SECTION 4. 346.03 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

346.03 (1) The operator of an authorized emergency vehicle, when responding to an emergency call or when in the pursuit of an actual or suspected violator of the

law or, when responding to but not upon returning from a fire alarm, when transporting an organ for human transplantation, or when transporting medical personnel for the purpose of performing human organ harvesting or transplantation immediately after the transportation, may exercise the privileges set forth in this section, but subject to the conditions stated in subs. (2) to (5).

SECTION 5. 346.03 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

vehicle by sub. (2) (a) applies only when the operator of the vehicle is giving visual signal by means of at least one flashing, oscillating, or rotating red light except that the visual signal given by a police vehicle or an organ transport vehicle under s. 340.01 (3) (dg) may be by means of a blue light and a red light which are flashing, oscillating, or rotating, except as otherwise provided in sub. (4m). The exemptions granted by sub. (2) (b), (c), and (d) apply only when the operator of the emergency vehicle is giving both such visual signal and also an audible signal by means of a siren or exhaust whistle, except as otherwise provided in sub. (4) or (4m).

SECTION 6. 346.94 (14) of the statutes is amended to read:

346.94 (14) Use of flashing blue lights along highways. Except as provided in ss. 346.03 (3) and 347.25 (1m) and (1s), no person may maintain or operate any device equipped with a flashing, oscillating, or rotating blue light within 100 feet of a highway if the light is visible from the highway and if the department or the local authority responsible for maintaining the highway determines that motorists would believe the light was the warning light of a police vehicle for an organ transport vehicle under s. 340.01 (3) (dg). This subsection does not apply to airport lights.

347.25 (1m) (a) A police vehicle under s. 340.01 (3) (a) and an organ transport vehicle under s. 340.01 (3) (dg) may be equipped with a blue light and a red light which are flashing, oscillating, or rotating.

SECTION 8. 347.25 (1m) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

347.25 (1m) (b) If the a police vehicle or an organ transport vehicle is so equipped, the lights shall be illuminated as required under s. 346.03 when the operator of the police vehicle is exercising the privileges granted under that section. On a marked police vehicle or an organ transport vehicle, the blue light shall be mounted on the passenger side of the vehicle and the red light shall be mounted on the driver side of the vehicle. When in use on an unmarked police vehicle, the blue light shall be displayed on the passenger side of the vehicle and the red light shall be displayed on the driver side of the vehicle. The lights shall be designed and displayed so as to be plainly visible and understandable from a distance of 500 feet during normal sunlight and during hours of darkness. No operator of a police vehicle or an organ transport vehicle may use the warning lights except when responding to an emergency call or when in pursuit of an actual or suspected violator of the law, when responding to but not upon returning from a fire alarm, when transporting an organ for human transplantation, when transporting medical personnel for the purpose of performing human organ harvesting or transplantation immediately after the transportation, or when necessarily parked on a highway in a position which is likely to be hazardous to traffic using the highway.

**SECTION 9.** 347.25 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

347.25 (4) No vehicle may be equipped with or display any blue colored light or lamp unless the vehicle is used in police work authorized by the state or a political
