


TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 374

A-Note

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 3, line 9: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
3 page 5, line 4 and substitute:

4 *fix quote* SECTION 9m. 347.25 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 347.25 (1) Except as provided in subs. (1m) (a), (1r) and (1s), an authorized
6 emergency vehicle may be equipped with one or more flashing, oscillating or rotating
7 red lights, except that ambulances, fire department equipment, and privately owned
8 motor vehicles under s. 340.01 (3) (d), (dg) or (dm) being used by personnel of a
9 full-time or part-time fire department or by members of a volunteer fire department
10 or rescue squad, or by an organ procurement organization or any person under an
11 agreement with an organ procurement organization, may be equipped with red or
12 red and white lights, and shall be so equipped when the operator thereof is exercising
13 the privileges granted by s. 346.03. The lights shall be so designed and mounted as

1 to be plainly visible and understandable from a distance of 500 feet both during
2 normal sunlight and during hours of darkness. No operator of an authorized
3 emergency vehicle may use the warning lights except when responding to an
4 emergency call or when in pursuit of an actual or suspected violator of the law, when
5 responding to but not upon returning from a fire alarm, when transporting an organ
6 for human transplantation, when transporting medical personnel for the purpose of
7 performing human organ harvesting or transplantation immediately after the
8 transportation, or when necessarily parked in a position which is likely to be
9 hazardous to traffic.”
