## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill eliminates the definition of county health department and instead, in a county with a population of less than 500,000, authorizes the county board and the governing body of a city that has a city health department to establish jointly a city-county health department. It is believed that this bill will affect the counties of Dane, Winnebago, Allegheny, Rock, Brown, and Jefferson. It is unknown how individual counties and municipalities will respond to the bill. As a result, the local government fiscal effect of the proposed bill is indeterminate.
