AN ACT ...; relating to: eligibility for Wisconsin tuition grants.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a resident student who is enrolled at least half-time at an accredited, nonprofit Wisconsin college or university is eligible for a tuition grant. This bill makes a resident student who is enrolled at least half-time in a Wisconsin branch or campus of an accredited, nonprofit college located in another state eligible for a tuition grant.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 39.30 (2) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

39.30 (2) ELIGIBILITY. (intro.) A resident student who is enrolled at least

half-time and registered as a freshman, sophomore, junior or senior in an accredited,

nonprofit, post-high school, educational institution in this state or who is so enrolled

and registered in an in-state branch or campus of an accredited, nonprofit, post-high
