## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

s.39.30, Wis. Stats. Tuition Grants provide grant assistance to undergraduate, Wisconsin residents enrolled at least half-time in degree or certificate programs at independent colleges or universities throughout Wisconsin. Wisconsin technical college students are not eligible for this assistance. Therefore, the proposal to expand eligibility for Tuition grants to students attending independent colleges or universities outside Wisconsin would not have a fiscal effect on state aid funds available to technical college students.
