## **2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 401**

May 15, 2001 – Introduced by Representatives Petrowski, Lippert, Jeskewitz, Suder, Ryba, Starzyk, Hahn, Musser, Rhoades, Friske, Huber and Sykora, cosponsored by Senator Darling. Referred to Committee on Education Reform.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 121.02 (1) (o); and *to repeal and recreate* 115.38 (2) of the 2 statutes; **relating to:** school and school district performance reports.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, each school board must annually distribute to the parent or guardian of each pupil enrolled in the school district a copy of the school and school district performance report, which contains information such as scores on statewide pupil examinations and attendance and retention rates. This bill requires instead that the school board send each parent or guardian a notice that the report is available upon the parent's or guardian's request, produce a copy of the report upon request, and, if the school district maintains an Internet site, make the report available to the public at that site.
