Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would prohibit an employer, including the State of Wisconsin, from discriminating against an employee who discloses his/her compensation to anyone.

Employees of the State of Wisconsin who felt their rights under the bill had been violated could file a complaint of discrimination with the Personnel Commission.

This estimate only addresses the fiscal consequences on the Personnel Commission of processing such claims. It does not reflect the costs to state agencies associated with defending the claims permitted by the bill or the costs to local government associated with defending claims filed with the Department of Workforce Development.

Approximately 200 complaints of discrimination are already processed by the Commission every year. The Commission assumes that no more than 1 or 2 additional complaints would be filed with the Commission annually under the bill. Existing staff would be able to absorb this nominal estimated increase in caseload without additional expenditures.
