

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 427**

November 6, 2001 – Offered by Representatives WASSERMAN and VRAKAS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 6: after “licenses” insert “, creating an exemption from such
3 licenses,”.

4 **2.** Page 5, line 1: before that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 10m.** 456.07 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 456.07 (5) Only Except as provided in s. 456.12, only an individual who has
7 qualified as a licensed and registered nursing home administrator under this
8 chapter and who holds a valid current registration certificate under this section for
9 the current registration period may use the title “Nursing Home Administrator”, and
10 the abbreviation “N.H.A.” after the person’s name. No other person may use or be
11 designated by such title or such abbreviation or any other words, letters, sign, card
12 or device tending to or intended to indicate that the person is a licensed and
13 registered nursing home administrator.”.
